Considering Renting your Farmland? Collaboration on Farmland Rental Agreements for Farmers and Landowners

Farmers need to see the benefits of good management in the long term, and landowners need reassurance about managing their land. As more of Ontario's farming is do ne on rented land, the significance of farmer-landowner relationships is increasing. A solution is a simple yet effective written lease. The lease would outline both parties' responsibilities and helps set collaborative goals, define the financial terms, and clarify the land management. It gives the farmer the security to make suitable land management investments with a longer-term perspective. And what about the cost? Will the rent be a flat rate? When will it be paid? Will the rate change over time? Will the rental amount be based on some formula that considers the value of the crop produced? And what about capital i mprovements? Who pays for a new culvert, a load of gravel or fencing repairs?
